τὰ κέρδη (helpful hints):

Greek words can end in a limited number of ways:

- with a vowel sound
- with the sounds -v, $-\varrho$, or $-\varsigma$ (which includes ξ or ψ)
- the only exceptions are the words ἐκ "out of, from" and οὐκ "not"
- if any other consonant would otherwise end a word, it simply disappears.
- but, because the Bible refers to many non-Greek names and places, you will see some names that violate these rules. For example "Adam" = $A\delta \dot{\alpha} \mu$.
