#### BIBLICAL READINGS

# supplement to Shelmerdine 2<sup>nd</sup> edition **Chapter 5**

## A. The Lord tells Moses what he will do to those who have sinned against Him:

ἐξαλείψω αὐτοὺς ἐκ τῆς βίβλου μου. (LXX Ex. 32.33)

ἐξαλείπω "blot" αὐτοὺς "them" (acc) βίβλος –ου ἡ "book" μου "my"

# B. A prayer from a psalm:

νομοθέτησόν με, Κύριε, ἐν τῆ ὁδῷ σου (LXX Ps. 27.11)

νομοθέτησον "instruct" (aor. command) με "me" Κύριος –ου ὁ "Lord" σου "your"

## C. At a synagogue in Nazareth, Jesus quotes a proverb:

Ἰατοὲ, θεράπευσον σεαυτόν· (Luke 4:23)

θεράπευσον "heal!" (aorist command); σεαυτόν "yourself" (acc)

# D. John the Baptist has asked if Jesus is the Messiah. Jesus acts before he sends a reply:

ἐν ἐκείνη ὥρᾳ ἐθεράπευσεν πολλοὺς ἀπὸ νόσων καὶ μαστίγων καὶ πνευμάτων πονηρῶν (Luke 7.21)

ἐκείνη "that" ὤρα  $-\alpha$ ς ή "hour," πολλοὺς "many" (acc), μαστίγων "illnesses" πνευμάτων πονηρῶν "evil spirits"

# E. The opening of the Gospel of John:

Έν ἀρχῆ ἦν ὁ λόγος, καὶ ὁ λόγος ἦν πρὸς τὸν θεόν, καὶ θεὸς ἦν ὁ λόγος (John 1.1) ἀρχή -ῆς ἡ "beginning" ἦν "was" θεός –οῦ ὁ "god"

#### F. Jesus foretells Peter's denial and continues:

Έγὼ εἰμι ή ὀδός καὶ ἡ ἀλήθεια καὶ ἡ ζωή· (John 14.6)

Έγὼ εἰμι "I am" ἀλήθεια -ας ἡ "truth" ζωή -ῆς ἡ "life"

#### G. Paul speaks of equality under baptism:

οὐκ ἔνι δοῦλος οὐδὲ ἐλεύθερος (Gal. 3.28)

οὐκ...οὐδὲ "neither...nor" ἔνι "there is" ἐλεύθερος "free"

#### H. Paul describes the runaway slave Onesimus after his conversion:

οὐκέτι ὡς δοῦλον ἀλλ' ὑπὲο δοῦλον (Philem 16)

οὐκέτι ώς "no longer as" ὑπὲρ +acc. "beyond"

#### I. A vision of death from the Apocalypse:

καὶ ἰδοὺ ἵππος λευκός (Rev. 6.2, 19.11)

ἰδοὺ "behold" λευκός "white"
