AGE 02 02: Verbs and Accents Worksheet

Review thoroughly the first page of the "Rule for Accents Verbs" handout (the section on Verbs and the Recessive Accent), as well as the second page (the section on Enclitic Accents and $\epsilon i\mu i$ and $\phi \eta \mu i$). Once this is done:

1. Provide the proper accents for the word/enclitic pairs. Supply the additional accents (if there are any) caused by the enclitic.

Note that the second word is always an enclitic. Though not all the following enclitics are forms of $\epsilon i \mu i$ and $\phi \eta \mu i$, ALL ENCLITICS follow the same rules of accents given on your accents handout.

2. Cite the accent rule that you are applying in each situation. This can be done by giving the Arabic Numeral from the section on Enclitic Accents and $\epsilon i\mu i$ and $\varphi \eta \mu i$.

e.g. ἄνθρωπος τινες: ἄνθρωπός τινες (1)

(here, it is 1 because "1" states that "If a verb form has three or more syllables, and the ultima of the word contains a single short vowel, the accent recedes to the antepenult")

ἀγαθοί τινες	ὑπλίτης τις
ἄνθρωπος ἐστιν	ἡμέρα ἐστι
στρατιῶται εἰσιν	ἀγαθῶν τινες
ὁπλίτης φησι	δέ ἐστιν
